# 1. The Importance of Shrewdness (vv. 1-8a)

- “The master commended the dishonest manager for his shrewdness.”

## 2. Do not serve worldly wealth, but shrewdly use it for godly, eternal purposes (vv. 8b-13)

- Verse 8b: “For the sons of this world are more shrewd in dealing with their own generation than the sons of light.”

## 2. Do not serve worldly wealth, but shrewdly use it for godly, eternal purposes (vv. 8b-13)

- Verse 9: “Make friends for yourselves by means of unrighteous wealth, so that when it fails they may receive you into the eternal dwellings.”
- Verse 13: “No servant can serve two masters, for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and money.”

- Verses 11-12: “If then you have not been faithful in the unrighteous wealth, who will entrust to you the true riches? And if you have not been faithful in that which is another’s, who will give you that which is your own?”
