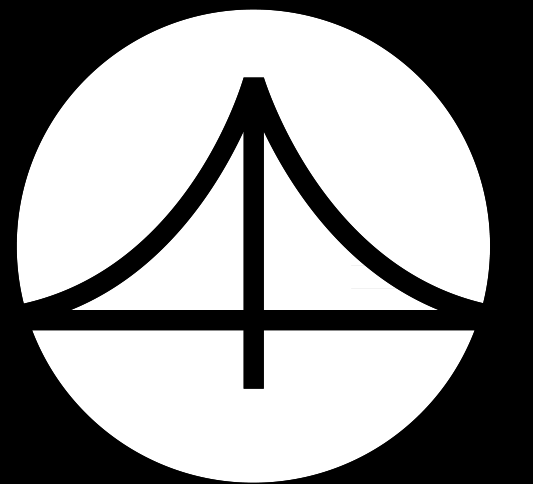

A Universal Experience

- 3 Sets of judgment: seals, trumpets, and bowls
 - 7 Seals: Everyone will suffer, but God uses suffering to purify Christians and bring justice
 - 7 Trumpets: God gives the unbelieving world warnings
 - 7 Bowls: For those who don't listen to God's warnings, His justice has the last word

Rev. 6:1-8:5

A Universal Experience

- White horse: Conquerors
- Red horse: War and conflict
- Black horse: Poverty
- Pale horse: Death
- All 4 horsemen are always at work in our world
- The presence of suffering in the world doesn't mean God's plans are in danger

Rev. 6:1-8:5

Special Suffering

- The whole world suffers, but Christians are singled out for special suffering
- God allows this because suffering purifies us
- God promises to bring justice for any unjust suffering we endure

Who Can Stand?

- The 144,000 of Israel and the great multitude from every nation are THE SAME group of people
- God seals, guards, and protects all His people
- Through the blood of Jesus, all Christians can stand before God's judgment
