



Tools of Trickery

1. Asks Questions

- Questions reshape how we see reality
- 2. Gets us to Forget God's Character
 - at the expense of other parts

 Questions built on wrong assumptions about the world that can't possibly have a right answer Gets us focused on one part of God's character



Tools of Trickery

3. Contradicts God

- doesn't
- 4. Twists the Truth
 - The best lie is the one that most closely resembles the truth

Waits until we're ready before the full attack Makes it seem like he cares about us and God

5. Promises Paradise Says his way, not God's, is the path to human flourishing
