
# Parables of Jesus in Luke: The Father's Welcome





# The Father rejoices when any son comes home.

### A Request for the Father

- Why does the father give his son the money?
- For him, money was a tool God gave him for the sake of loving the people around him and helping them become the people God wanted them to be
- How would we use money differently if we saw it as a tool for teaching our kids to live for Jesus?

## The Father and Younger Son

- The son blows through the money in no time
- The church is meant to be the safe place for people to run to when they hit rock bottom
- The father sees the son, feels compassion, and moves toward him
- In the father's house, there's nothing you can do and nowhere you can go that makes you unwelcome when you come home

#### The Father and Older Son

- He refuses to go into the party
- So the father comes out to invite him in
- The story ends on a cliffhanger: Will the older brother join the party?

#### The Father and You

- Jesus puts His entire audience (and you and me) into the story
- The open questions at the end of the story are meant to be answered by the audience in their own lives
- Jesus didn't come to fill the world with good moral people, He came to bring lost people home to God
